## Glenn to continue career at Spoon River College

CANNELTON—Brandi Glenn, the starting point guard for Cannelton's girls basketball team the last three years, will now get a chance to play the same role for Spoon River Community College.

Wednesday afternoon Glenn signed a letter-of-intent to play for the Canton, Ill. (about 35 miles southwest of Peoria) school.

She said she chose the Crusaders "because I was guaranteed playing time and I liked the school—it's small (700 full-time students)."

Spoon River Coach Mike Simpson, who began recruiting Glenn after seeing a videotape of her performance in this year's

win over South Spencer, said her passing ability was what he liked best. "She passes the ball real well—we haven't had a point guard who can do that."

"She also shoots the ball well," he said, adding that she may have to shoot a little more in college.

As for what she needs to work on most to get ready for college ball, Simpson said, "She dribbles a little high."

With no point guards returning from this year's 3-27 Spoon River team, Glenn has a good chance to start at that position. "Nobody's guaranteed anything, but the point guard position is open," said Simpson.

It's understandable that Simpson liked Glenn's passing ability, as at Cannelton she set

school records for most assists in a game (16), season (114) and career (341), averaging over five per game each of the last two years).

Simpson said he also liked the way she pushes the ball up the court, which fits well with the style of play he plans to use next season. "We're going to press and run," he said.

Glenn averaged 8.6 points, 4.2 rebounds and 3.1 steals for Cannelton this season and hit 66.2 percent of her free throws.

She helped the Bulldogs to a 15-7 record, the second best in school history.

She is undecided on a college major. "I just plan to get my general education classes out of the way (at the two-year school)," she said.

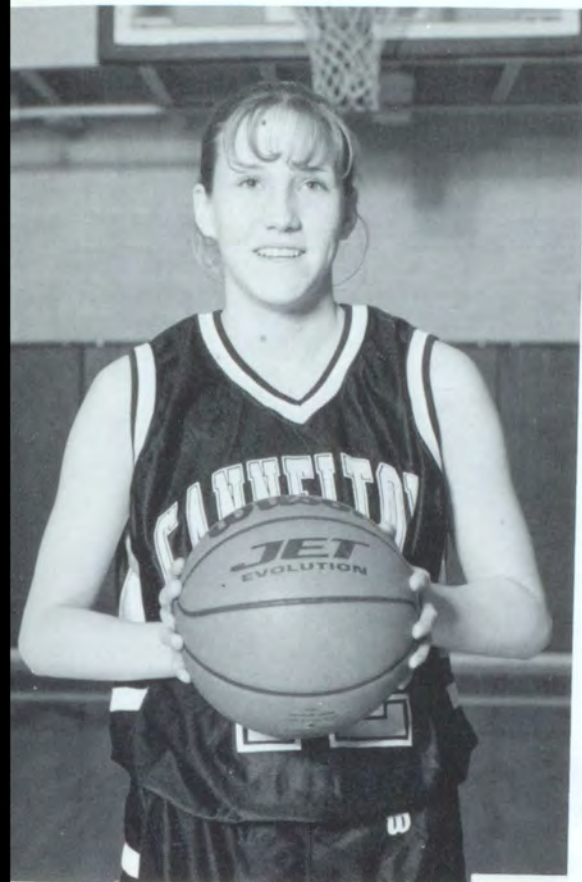

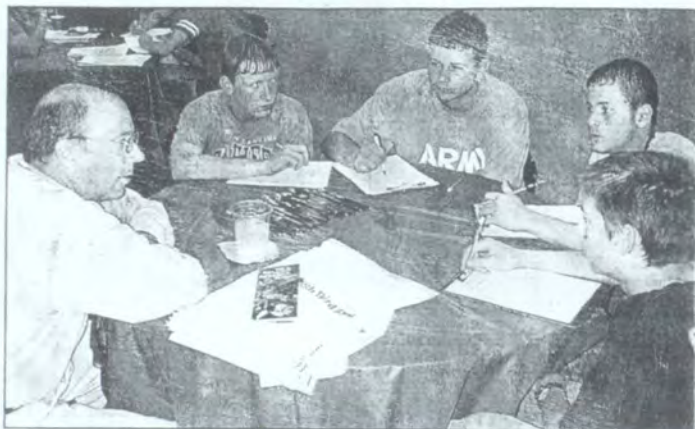

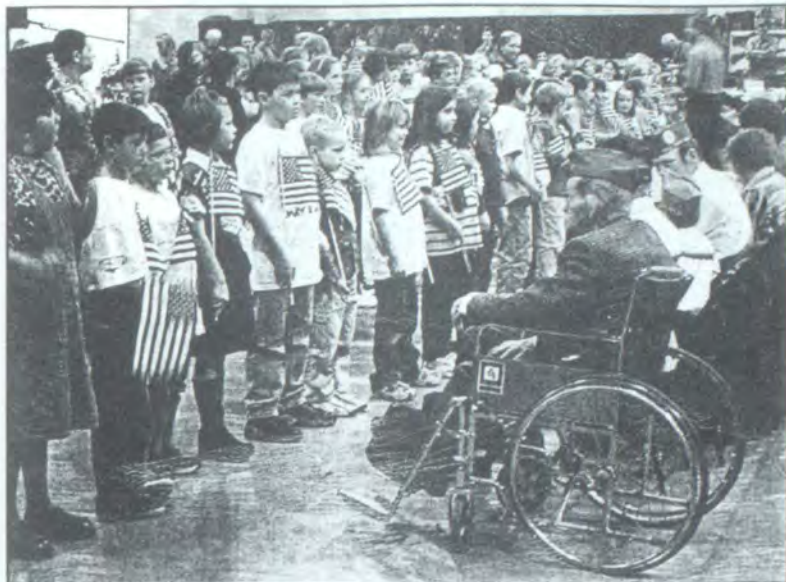

## Students host area veterans

CANNELTON—More than 200 persons packed the Cannelton Community Center Thursday as veterans from Perry County as well as across Indiana were honored in a two-hour Veterans Day program sponsored by Cannelton City Schools.

The Southern Indiana Veterans Program was held in honor of all Indiana veterans with special recognition for surviving World War I veteran Joseph Clyde Riley Sr. of Cannelton, who turned 104 on Saturday.

The Cannelton National Guard posted colors for the event which was hosted by Major James C. Gentry of Indianapolis,

executive officer for the First Battalion, 152nd Infantry of the U.S. Army. Gentry spoke of the discipline and bravery of soldiers past and present and of the military history of the area. "You live in an area that is rich in military history," he said. "The citizens of Cannelton have always taken great pride in serving their country."

The students also gave special recognition to two Cannelton heroes, Ralph Irvin, 88, a veteran of World War II and Earl Davis, 79, a survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor.

Students in grades 1 through 12 entertained veterans and guests with singing, music and

performances by flag corps, the Cannelton Community and High School Band and the Cannelton High School cheerleaders.

Newly hired Junior Senior High School Principal Sheila Donis was responsible for bringing the idea for the veterans program to fruition. Donis, who had organized similar events before coming to Cannelton, began planning for the event shortly after taking on her new role.

Donis and planners of the event said they are already making plans for next year's festivities. They hope to make the event into an annual Veterans Day program that will grow in popularity each year.

CANNELTON—For the first time in at least 25 years, Cannelton City Schools hosted a science fair, pitting student against student in an all-out quest for the best demonstration of science.

More than 95 entries lined the floor of the Cannelton Community Center April 19, some large and intricate, others small and simple, but all demonstrating students' hypotheses and tests of the laws of science.

Cannelton High School Principal Sheila Donis was the driving force behind the formation of the science fair. She said schools where she has taught in the past have always had them, "even when I taught at the inner-city schools in Chicago," she said.

Donis feels that the project helps the students in many ways. She said the kids not only learn from their own projects, but also look at everyone else's projects and learn from them as well.

A panel of judges selected from the community reviewed each of the projects and interviewed the students who created them. Donis said this portion of the project helps students work on their social skills and artistic creation.

Donis calls the project an "integrated learning experi-

ence," combining skills learned in several classes. Students work on the writing and research-report portions of their projects in English and language arts classes, presentation in graphic arts and experimentation in science classes.

"The idea is to raise expectations on all levels," Donis said. "We want our students to have the same opportunities as those at other schools." Donis said

she plans to make the science fair an annual event and has considered adding a history fair in the future.



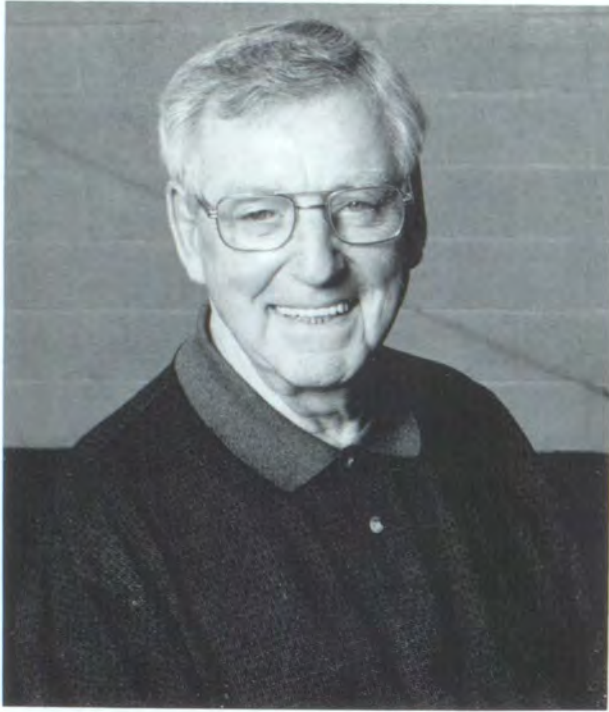
